PLAN OF ACTION 2019 (BULLETIN 17)

PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS AND WATCH THE DEADLINES.

Girls State will be held at Stonehill College, 320 Washington Street, Easton MA 02357 from Saturday, **June 15 - 21, 2019**. Girls are to arrive between the hours of **9:00a.m. – 10:30a.m. Saturday the 15th (classes start at 11:00am)** and all citizens must be off the campus by **2 p.m. on Friday the 21, 2019**.

The fee for Girls State citizens will be **\$350.00** paid by **April 1, 2019** and **\$375.00** after that. The **DEADLINE FOR MONIES**, to be **sent into the DEPARTMENT OFFICE** for Girls State Citizens is, **NO LATER THAN MAY 25, 2019 UNLESS PRE-ARRANGED WITH THE DIRECTOR.**

AT THIS TIME THERE IS A LIMIT OF 350 GIRLS – SO IT'S IMPERATIVE YOU FOLLOW THE DEADLINES!

You MUST use the attached REGISTRATION SHEET to send in your money!

The selection of the Girls State attendee is vital to the program. Girls State affords participants an opportunity to live together as self-governing citizens by informing them about the privileges, rights and responsibilities of American citizenship.

Marketing and Citizen Selection Goal: Partner with schools about the Girls State Program. Information provided to schools should help identify and prepare young women for the lessons of government and leadership.

The program objectives are:

- To develop leadership and pride in American citizens
- To educate citizens about our system of government
- To instill a greater understanding of American traditions
- To stimulate a desire to maintain our democratic government processes
- To encourage all eligible ALA Girl State citizen (past or present) to join the American Legion Auxiliary.
- Promote opportunity and benefits of membership as a resource for volunteerism
- **MUST BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE ENTIRE WEEK.**

Awards: Million Membership Mission Award – Units that demonstrate how working the mission of the ALA Girls Nation Committee engaged, retained and attracted members to grow membership in the unit. They will receive a citation plaque for the **Best Unit in each division**. A special citation will be given to each unit that demonstrates the criteria.

Entries are due to the Girls State Director no later than April 15, 2019.

Girls are eligible to attend Girls State if they meet the following criteria:

- Completed Junior year in high school the same year as current Girls State
- Interested in government and current events
- Have high moral characters
- Have strong leadership abilities
- Have an above average scholastic standing
- **MUST BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE ENTIRE WEEK**

NO MONEY CAN BE RETURNED TO YOU IF YOUR CITIZEN DECIDES NOT TO ATTEND, OR DOES NOT SHOW UP AT GIRLS STATE. WE ARE CHARGED FOR THE COUNT GIVEN TO THE COLLEGE. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU CHOOSE ALTERNATES ALONG WITH YOUR CITIZENS SO IF A GIRL CAN NOT COME YOU HAVE ANOTHER GIRL TO CHOOSE.

Orientation Goal: Provide information to volunteers and delegates to facilitate a successful Girls State Session.

- Orientation sessions are held in each District (or combined districts) so that all citizens can learn first-hand what is expected of them and what they can expect from the Girls State Program. A policy for the selection of delegates should be in place, which may include a written essay, a questionnaire and certainly a personal interview. You should ask questions about how they feel pledging allegiance to our flag, inspirational thoughts and prayers.
- Girls State teaches the citizens through hands on experience, the workings of City/Town and State Government. The girls learn by doing, setting up cities and towns, elections of their local officials, writing and debating bills using parliamentary procedure, and the election of their Constitutional Officers. We also have law, economics and government classes. They also have the opportunity to perform as a team submitting scenarios, budgets and in the process learn about themselves and what they can do.

Girls Nation Goal: The American Legion Auxiliary provides a select number of young women a unique citizenship educational opportunity by continuing their experience in governmental practice. They get to meet US Congressmen and senators from their state. They also may have the opportunity to meet the President of the United States.

- Two Girls State Citizens will be selected to represent the state as a US Senator to Girls Nation which will convene at the National 4-H Conference Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland, July 20 – 27, 2019 for the purpose of experiencing Federal Government.

Public Relations Goal: Create a program to educate the public about the importance of the educational opportunities afforded young women attending Girls State and Girls Nation sessions and demonstrate how this education will help create a more informed nation.

- Maintain high profile by using the name and symbol of the American Legion Auxiliary whenever dealing with the public.
