

## 2023- 2024 ALA MA Girls State Sponsor Information Packet

The 2024 program dates are from **Saturday June 15th** thru **Friday June 21st** at Stonehill College in Easton MA. Arrival is between **9am and 10:30am** Saturday morning (first meeting is at 11) and students can be picked up as early as **11am on Friday**, and need to be off campus by 2pm the latest. **Students are not permitted to leave campus** for other commitments, so decisions should be made with this in mind.

Sponsorship is **\$350** until **April 1st**, and will increase to **\$375** until the final deadline of **May 20th**. I **cannot** accept late submissions.

**\*\*\*PAY ATTENTION TO THE DEADLINES!\*\*\***

I have these deadlines set up to allow the **students** time to prepare. It is not fair to turn them away because of late sponsorship, and it's also not fair to force them to rush to prep.

**FOLLOWING THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW AND ON THE FORM ARE NECESSARY TO BE SURE ALL INFORMATION IS CORRECT ON BOTH ENDS OF THE SPONSORSHIP!**

**STEP 1:** Send form on the following page, along with the check, to Andrea (Director).

- Andrea will then email you a new information packet. **Let Andrea know if you need a paper copy mailed to you!**

**STEP 2:** The second packet has a **new form**. Send this new form to Andrea by **May 25th!** This is how the **student** will get program information from Andrea. Andrea will be reaching out directly to the students with information. If she doesn't hear back from the student, she will then reach out to you.

- Andrea and/or the district chair will reach out to each sponsor and student with both in person and online orientation information for your area.

**STEP 3:** Andrea will reach out directly to the students with their check-in information **1 week** prior to the start of the program.

### What makes a good citizen?

**\*\*\*CITIZENS MUST BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE ENTIRE WEEK!**

- Citizens will not be allowed to leave the program to attend another commitment during the week, and return to campus.
- Late arrivals must be approved by the Director, and students must be on campus by Saturday before lights out.

Partner with schools to provide information on how to identify and prepare potential candidates. The objectives of the program are:

- To develop leadership and pride in American citizens.
- To educate citizens about our system of government.
- To instill a greater understanding of American traditions.
- To stimulate a desire to maintain our democratic government process.
- To encourage all eligible ALA Girls State citizens (past and present) to join the American Legion Auxiliary.
- Promote opportunity and benefits of membership as a resource for volunteerism.

The American Legion Auxiliary provides a select number of ALA Girls State citizens an educational opportunity by continuing their experience on the national level at **Girls Nation**. They will meet with members of the US Congress and their State Representatives. There is also a chance they could take a trip to the White House.

- Two ALA MA Girls State representatives will be selected after an interview process during the week. The ALA Girls Nation program will be held from **July 20-27 2024**.

**\*\*\*NO FUNDS may be returned if your delegate decides not to attend, or doesn't show up at the program. We are charged the count given to the college prior to the week's start. It is vital that you choose an alternate as well, so if your first choice cannot attend, you will not lose your funds.\*\*\***
